How to reach Granada city centre from Granada airport.

It is suggested to take the <u>Alsa bus</u> service.

You can find the buses outside the arrival terminal on the right side.

Buses for Granada City Centre will depart from the airport approximately 30 minutes after the arrival of each flight, and you can get off after around 60 minutes in the city centre (Final stop according to your hotel location). The most centrical stop and closed to the School of Architecture of Granada is the Cathedral stop,

The one-way fare is &3,10, and you can purchase online or in the bus, in this case it is convenient to have it in cash because sometimes it is not possible to pay with the credit card.

Buses depart from Granada Airport and follow this route to reach the city centre: Airport > Santa Fe > Bellas Artes > Plaza Europa > Bus Station > Plaza San Isidro > Triunfo (Cóndor Hotel) > Gran Vía ("El Americano" building) > Gran Vía (Cathedral) > Puerta Real (Corte Inglés) > Palacio de Congresos.

Alternatively, you can take a taxi from the airport to the city centre.

You can have a shared taxi for  $\in 10$  (with a minimum of 4 passengers); or a private ride has an approximate tariff of  $\in 30-40$  (it is recommended to ask the taxi driver the price before getting on, there is no fixed fee).

How to reach the Granada city centre from Malaga airport.

As Málaga is an international airport located relatively close to Granada, it may be a convenient choice for your arrival. The city is well connected to Granada, with regular bus services operated by ALSA.

Please be aware that tickets must be purchased online and in advance via the ALSA website, as they tend to sell out quickly.

Buses to Granada depart directly from the area in front of the arrivals hall at Terminal 3 of Málaga Airport.

Point of departure Malaga Airport







It is important to select "Málaga Airport" as your point of departure (not just "Málaga") to ensure that the bus takes you directly to the Granada Bus Station. From Granada Bus Station to the city centre, you catch the bus line 33. The bus stop is in front of the main entrance of the bus station. Bus tickets are sold directly on the bus and paid to the bus driver in CASH (1.40 EUR). Keep the bus ticket if you want to transfer lines (you have 60 minutes for transfers).

You will have to get off the bus at the following bus stops to reach the city centre.

- "Catedral" if your destination is Gran Vía, Plaza Nueva, Albaicín or Realejo.

How to reach the School of Architecture from the city centre:

If you stop by the Cathedral, you can reach the School of Architecture either by walking, it is approximately a 12-minute walk, or by taking public transportation from the Isabel la Católica stop, located about 200 meters away.


You can take bus lines C30, C32, or C35. The nearest stops to the School of Architecture are Plaza del Realejo or Molinos 38.

The fare is  $\pounds$ 1.60, and you can pay in cash on the bus or purchase a ticket at the machines located at some of the bus stops.

How to reach the ISP / BIP location from your accommodation:

It is possible to reach the School of Architecture (ETSAG) either by public transportation or on foot, depending on the location of your accommodation. We recommend checking the distance from your hotel to the School before making a reservation.

The public bus lines mentioned above, C30, C32, and C35, serve the city centre and pass through the Realejo district, where the School of Architecture is located.

Suggested location of accommodations.

Our recommendation is to stay in the city centre, as it provides easy access to the School of Architecture. Booking accommodation in this area will also allow you to enjoy the city centre during the evenings and make it easier to reach the School on foot.

Below is a map highlighting the recommended area for accommodation. The entire zone is walkable, with an average distance of approximately 30 minutes from one end to the other. This area is also well-frequented and generally considered safe for visitors
