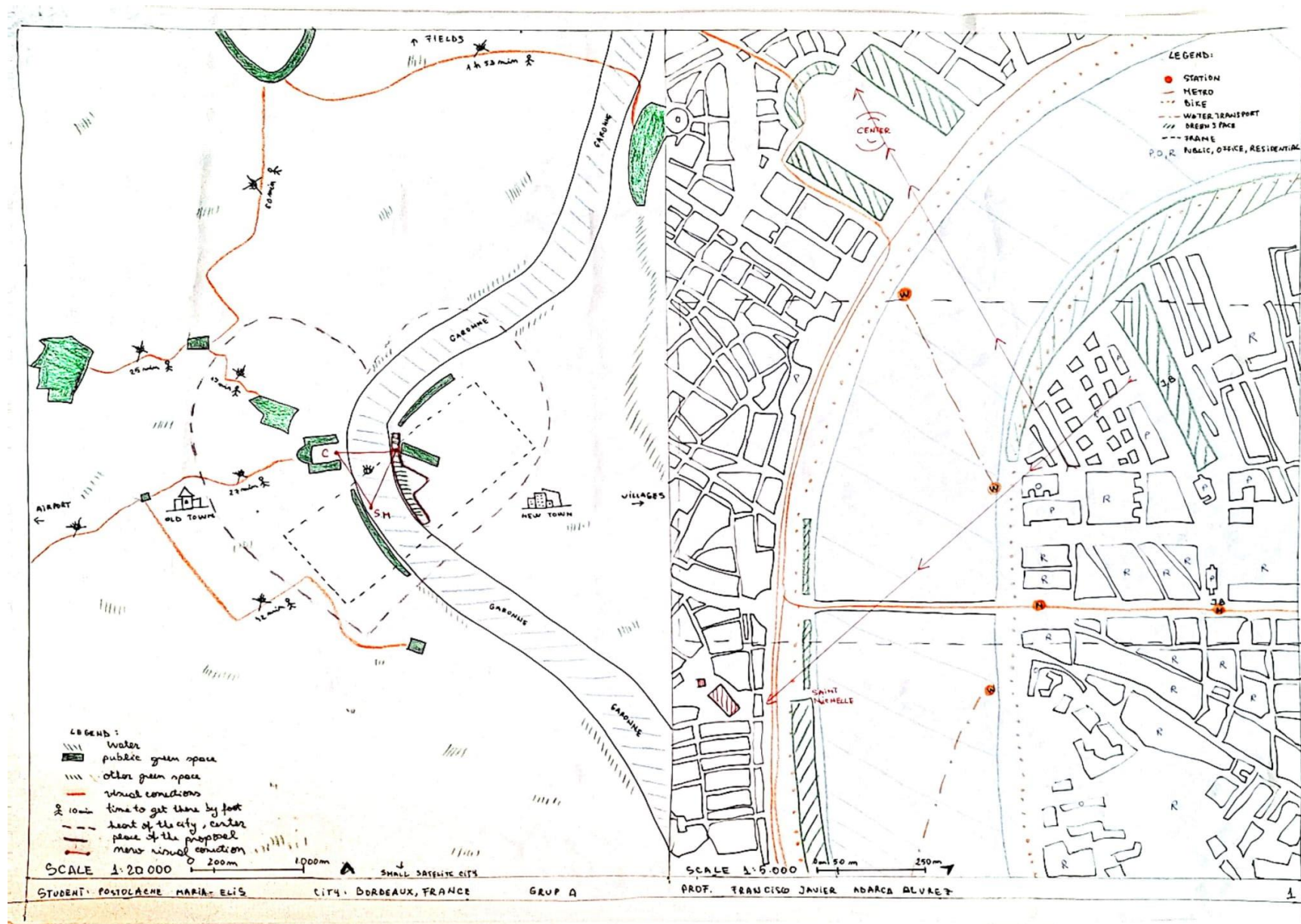

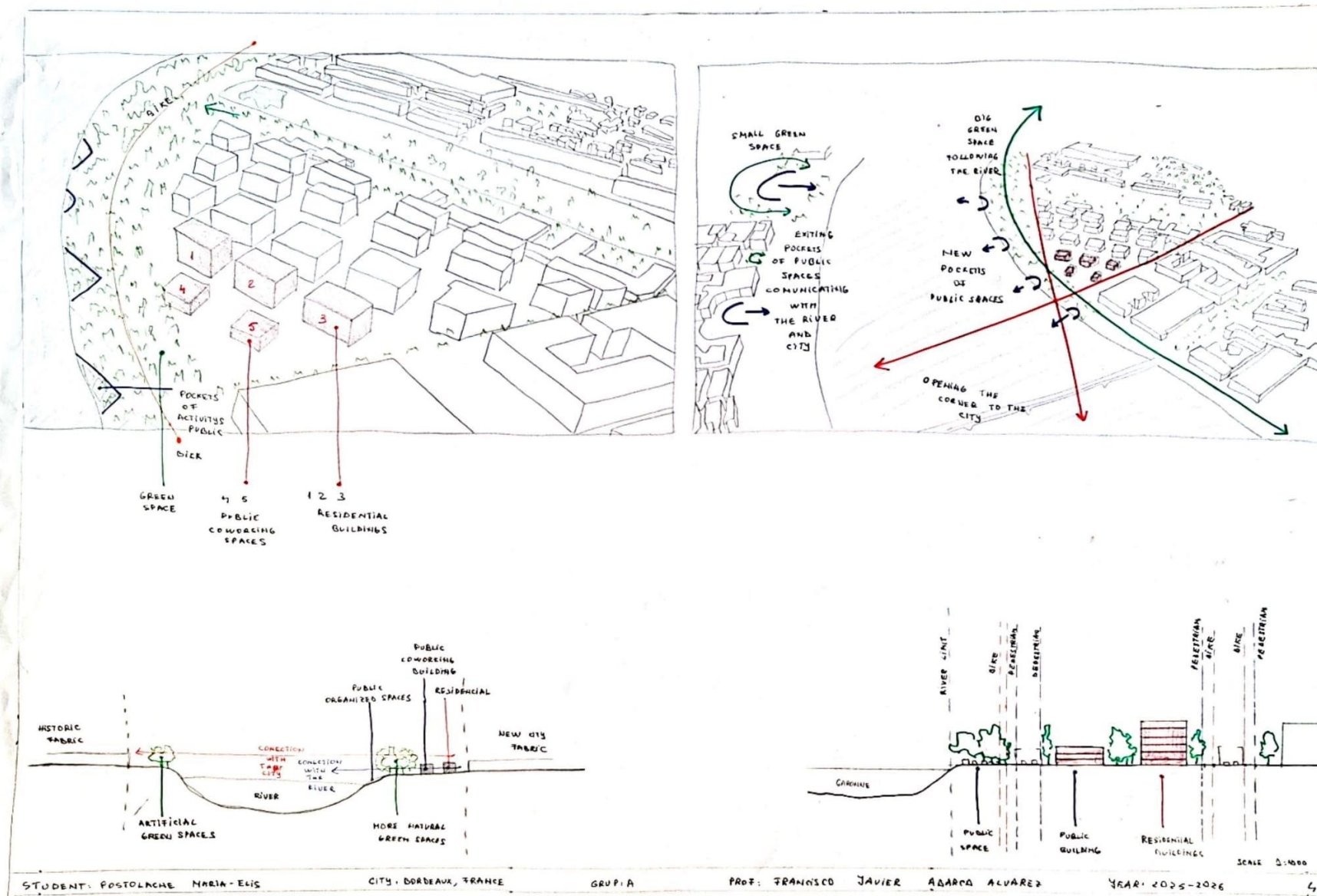
Strategy for development Bodeaux, France

My project aims to introduce the team's shared strategy of improving the quality of green spaces in the city of Bordeaux. After analyzing the areas where such a solution could be implemented, the less developed and more natural right bank emerged as the most suitable choice. Positioned with a corner oriented toward the central area and opening toward key urban nodes, the site allows for the emergence of a new urban intervention.





Thus, the proposal creates new public pockets that act as platforms for social activities within a controlled yet natural green environment, directly connected to both banks of the river and to the river itself. Everything tied by a biking and pedestrian ribbon across the river making things accessible.



The newly introduced spaces include three residential buildings with a ground floor plus five upper levels (G+5), two public buildings with functions that support a wide range of social activities, and a riverbank area featuring outdoor gyms, children's playgrounds, a skate park, an amphitheater with a small stage oriented toward the water, and many other public amenities.
