
## Rīgas Ziedi



















Rīgas Ziedi is an utopian urban regeneration project that reimagines the Āgenskalns district of Riga as a living ecosystem — a city-garden where nature, community, and technology coexist in perfect balance.

Its innovation lies in transforming an existing neighborhood into a self-sufficient urban organism:

1. Architecture grows like nature, using bio-based materials such as mycelium and timber, with façades that purify the air.

2. Urban farming becomes infrastructure, turning rooftops, courtyards, and walls into productive green spaces.

3. Mobility is redefined through car-free, pedestrian-friendly routes, bike paths, and river taxis along the Daugava.

4. Energy and resources circulate locally, powered by solar, wind, and biogas systems governed through a transparent community blockchain.
5. Culture and social life thrive in shared spaces — open-air theatres, workshops, and a "Living Library" that connects generations.

Rīgas Ziedi challenges traditional urban design by merging ecology, technology, and collective governance, transforming Riga into a model of sustainable and creative living for future cities.
