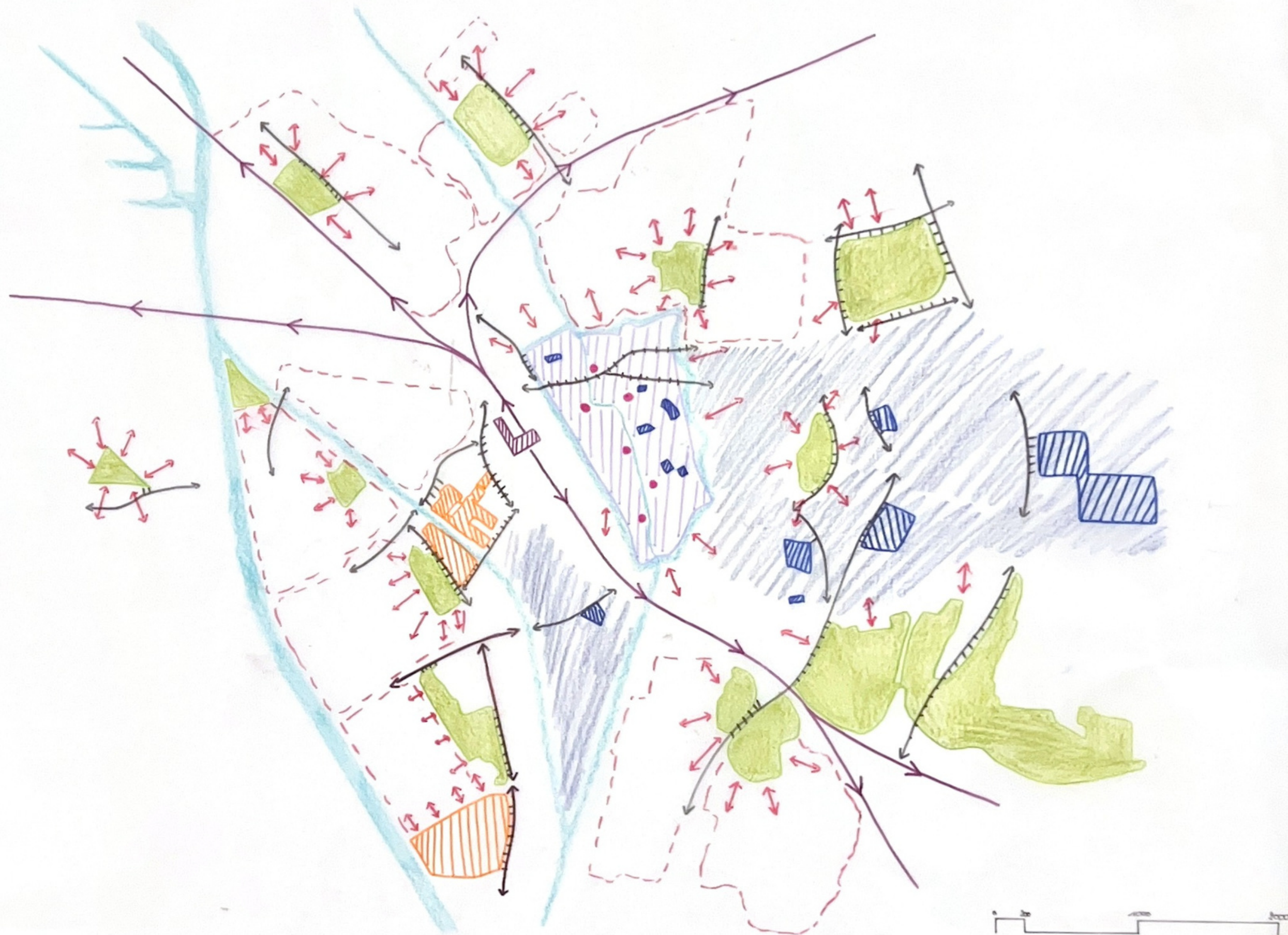

# UTRECHT

Utopia: *Vegetal and Hyper-Connected City*

The world has found peace thanks to the Hyperloop, a technological network that has united major cities. One of its lines connects Rome, Florence, Zurich, Utrecht, and Amsterdam ; a progress that has revolutionized mobility and urban planning. In the Netherlands, car usage has plummeted by over 50%, now confined to leaving the city. In Utrecht, the city is entirely pedestrian, its streets transformed into cobblestone paths lined with trees. Public transport has been intensified, notably with the proliferation of modern suspended metros.

The Hyperloop, traveling 30 meters high, has redefined the landscape. New buildings with organic, green architecture have sprung up along its route, drastically changing the urban form. Lush vegetation covers everything, offering a city rich in oxygen, connected, and serene, all while respecting the integrity of the historic district.
